Introduction

Constitution (Section 24):

- An environmental right
- Everyone has the right -
 - to an environment that is not harmful to health or well-being; and
 - to have the environment protected, for the benefit of present and future generations, through reasonable legislative and other measures (EPWP Projects) that-
 - (i) prevent pollution and ecological degradation;
 - (ii) promote conservation; and
 - (iii) secure ecologically sustainable development and use of natural resources while promoting justifiable economic and social development.

Factors that influence Sustainability



Shifting One's Mind

- Take **social, ecological and economic aspects** into account- These aspects influence sustainability
- Projects must be sustainable and viable
- Projects must be approached holistically (look bigger picture)
- Link and align projects to strategic plans and frameworks i.e. ECBCP, Alfred Nzo EMF, Alfred Nzo Climate Change Strategy Plan

Shifting One's Mind

- Employment of competent people (CV's)
- Put aside political agendas and self gain objectives
- Improved synergy and partnerships between Gov and NGOs
- Develop clear objectives, deliverables and ways to measure project success
- Implement and budget for maintenance and project follow-up
